- BH01 Tenuta di Gracciano della Seta** **34**  
SANGIOVESE-MERLOT, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Toscana, IT, 2022 - 375ml  
*Full-bodied & rustic, black cherry, cooked plum, anise, red roses, spice. In Montepulciano, “Bravio delle Botti” is an annual, competitive race of rolling wine barrels through the city.*
- BH02 Cantina del Pino** **55**  
NEBBIOLO, Barbaresco, Piemonte, IT, 2020 - 375ml  
*Polished & broad, ripe cherry, red plum, black pepper, tobacco, roses. Originally owned by Domizio Cavazza, the estate was named after the pine tree planted to honor his first son’s birth.*
- BH03 Ciacci Piccolomini d’Aragona** **60**  
SANGIOVESE, Brunello di Montalcino, Toscana, IT, 2020 - 375ml  
*Rich & complex, lush black cherry, black plums, grilled rosemary, orange peel. This 17th-century estate was gifted by the Countess Ciacci to the current family of farmers who work the land.*

- B011 Punta Crena Frizzante Bianco** **48**  
LUMASSINA, Colline Savonesi, Liguria, IT, 2021  
*Light bodied w/ slight spritz, sea salt, passionfruit, Marcona almonds. Overlooking the Mediterranean coast, this winery exemplifies honest expressions of indigenous varieties.*
- B012 Brigo Vini “Balotta” Vino Frizzante Secco** **45**  
LAMBRUSCO GRASPAROSSA, Lambrusco dell’Emilia, Emilia Romagna, IT, 2023  
*Brambly & dry, red berries, fruit punch, woody earth. A wine for good food and good friends, it is only right that “Balotta” means “to friendly chat around the table.”*
- B013 Bera Vittoria e Figli “Arcese”** **48**  
ARNEIS-CORTESE-SAUVIGNON BLANC-VERMENTINO, Canelli, Piemonte, IT, 2022  
*Funky & unfiltered, citrus, almond, biscuit, white flowers. A co-fermented field blend topped off w/ residual sugar creating a pétillant naturelle wine w/ light effervescence.*
- B014 Conti di Buscareto Rosato Brut** **50**  
LACRIMA DI MORRO, Marche, IT, NV  
*Sparkling rosé & dry, strawberries, raspberries, rose flowers, violets. The thin skin of this grape allows tear-like drops of juice to be expelled and to drip: hence the name “Lacrima.”*

### SPARKLING: METODO CLASSICO

- B021 Temellini Spumante Millesimato Extra Brut** **60**  
GARGANEGA, Soave, Veneto, IT, 2020  
*Expressive & floral, brioche, fresh apple, peach, almonds, acacia, & jasmine flowers. This classic method sparkling wine spends 5 years on lees before release. Great quality for price.*
- B022 Monzio Compagnoni Satèn** **70**  
CHARDONNAY, Franciacorta, Lombardia, IT, 2020  
*Creamy texture w/ silky bubbles, citrus, vanilla, biscuit, white flowers. The term ‘Saten’ means ‘silky’ in the native dialect, referring to the light, elegant quality of the bubbles.*
- B023 Bruno Giacometto “Erbaluce di Caluso” Brut** **80**  
ERBALUCE, Piemonte, IT, 2012  
*Delicious & punchy, pink lady apple, lemon, acacia. Erbaluce creates high-acid white wines, which became the first white DOC zone in Piemonte in 1967, and elevated to DOCG in 2010.*
- B024 Fontanafredda “Contessa Rosa” Rosé Brut Riserva** **120**  
CHARDONNAY-PINOT NERO, Alta Langa, Piemonte, IT, 2016  
*Sparkling rosé & dry, orange blossom, pomegranate, ginger, lavender. A hedonistic bubbles fit for royalty, using the liqueur d’expédition of their 1967 Barolo in the dosage.*

### WHITE: LIGHTER & CRISP

- B111 **Collina Serragrilli** 48  
CORTESE, Gavi di Gavi, Piemonte, IT, 2023  
*Well-structured & bright, ripe apples, pears, wildflowers. The perfect aperitif or first-course starter, Gavi di Gavi is always a crowd favourite.*
- B112 **Fratelli Ponte** 54  
ARNEIS, Roero, Piemonte, IT, 2024  
*Honest & refreshing, fresh lemon, ripe apple, pear, & chamomile. Arneis means “little rascal” in Piemontese, because of its difficulty to grow. It is also known as “Barolo Bianco.”*
- B113 **Angelo Negro “Onorata”** 58  
FAVORITA, Langhe, Piemonte, IT, 2024  
*Linear & bright, green apple, lemon peel, geranium, almond, stony minerality. Historians believe Favorita to be a Vermentino clone, transplanted from Sardinia.*

### WHITE: ROUND & FULL

- B121 **Fattoria La Rivolta** 48  
FALANGHINA del Sannio, Campania, IT, 2022  
*Lingering & emboldened, white peach, yellow apple, citrus, flowers. Falanghina is an ancient variety from the Latin “falangae,” or the stakes used to support the vines.*
- B122 **Bio Vio Giobatta “Aimone”** 50  
VERMENTINO, Riviera Ligure di Ponente, Liguria, IT, 2023  
*Classic & textural, crisp green apple, grapefruit, lime sorbet, Mediterranean herbs. These Vermentino vines average 60 years of age, increasing the concentration & quality of the wine.*
- B123 **Ca’ dei Frati “I Frati”** 60  
TURBINA, Lugana, Lombardia, IT, 2023  
*Fresh & round, white balsamic, flowers, grapefruit, white peach, almonds. Named “Ca’ dei Frati” or “friar house” after the monks who tended the vines in the region.*
- B114 **Chateau Feuillet** 70  
PETIT ARVINE, Valle d’Aosta, IT, 2022  
*Explosive w/ personality, ripe peaches, yellow apple, citrus, & hazelnuts. From northern Italy, this is the closest thing to French wine at Enoteca; it literally shares the border at St. Pierre.*
- B131 **Domaine Sigalas** 90  
ASSYRTIKO, Santorini, GR, 2024  
*Full & complex, ripe lemon, white peach, flowers in full bloom, herbs, chalk, salinity. Considered the “genius of Santorini,” Paris Sigalas is responsible for putting Assyrtiko on the world stage.*

## WHITE: CHARDONNAY-NAY

- B132 **Domaine Papagiannakos “Vareli”** 50  
SAVATIANO, Markopoulo, Attika, GR, 2023  
*Enriching & rounded, citrus fruit, apricot, creamy peaches, caramel, baking spices. The perfect exploration for the Chardonnay lover, this wine sees 6 months in New French Oak.*
- B133 **Grillo Iole** 58  
RIBOLLA GIALLA, Friuli Colli Orientali, IT, 2022  
*Full-bodied & floral, fresh yellow apple, white peach rose & acacia flowers. “Colli Orientali” means “Hills towards the Orient,” the best sites being West, thus maximizing sun exposure.*
- B134 **Villa Bucci** 62  
VERDICCHIO dei Castelli di Jesi Classico, Marche, IT, 2022  
*Fragrant & expressive, lemon, green apple, white blossoms, almonds, salinity. A winery known for elevating the quality of Verdicchio w/ the use of micro-oxygenation through used oak.*
- B124 **Cantele “Teresa Manara”** 66  
CHARDONNAY, Salento, Puglia, IT, 2023  
*Silky & nuanced, green apple, lemon, acacia flowers, light spice. “Teresa Manara,” a tribute to the winemaker’s mother, this wine represents a resilience to produce quality Italian Chardonnay.*

## WHITE: THE BEST OF THE BEST

- B141 **Maugeri “Contrada Volpare”** 90  
CARRICANTE, Etna Bianco Superiore, Sicilia, IT, 2022  
*Vibrant & concentrated, lemon curd, citrus peel, ginger, Mediterranean herbs. An exciting, terroir-driven expression of this indigenous variety from the east-facing slopes of Mount Etna.*
- B142 **Fontanafredda “Derthona”** 110  
TIMORASSO, Colli Tortonesi, Piemonte, 2023  
*Emboldened & full, green apple, exotic fruits, green olives, crushed stones. Timorasso is known as the “white Barolo” for its reputation for creating complex & ageworthy wines.*
- B143 **Gaja Ca’Marcanda “Vistamare”** 130  
VERMENTINO-VIOGNIER-FIANO, Maremma, Toscana, IT, 2022  
*Rich & expressive, pink grapefruit, chamomile, peach, apricot, cantaloupe. Gaja’s version of a white Super Tuscan, “Vistamare,” means “seacoast,” reminiscent of the luxurious Italian coast.*
- B144 **Liviu Felluga “Terre Alte”** 180  
FRIULANO-PINOT BIANCO-SAUVIGNON, Rosazzo, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, IT, 2021  
*Seductive & complex, orange blossom, honeysuckle, yellow grapefruit, papaya, rosemary, & sage. Created in 1981, Terre Alte is considered one of Italy’s most prestigious white wines.*

### SKIN CONTACT: AMBER, RETSINA, ROSÉ - OH MY

- B151 **Ktmia Gerovassiliou Single Vineyard** 66  
MALAGOUSIA, Epanomi, GR, 2023  
*Clean w/ skin contact, pineapple, peach, exotic fruits, & beeswax. This winemaker saved the Malagousia grape from extinction, using his oldest plot of the variety for this bottling.*
- B152 **Cantina Gungui “en Rose” Rosato** 95  
CANNONAU di Sardegna, IT, 2024  
*Complex & serious, wild strawberry, redcurrant, Mediterranean herbs. This wine is a “rosé gastronomique”, think Château Pibarnon, a wine drinker’s wine. Only 1400 bottles produced.*
- B153 **Mylonas “Retsina”** 48  
SAVATIANO, Attiki, GR, NV  
*Traditionally aged w/ pine resin, mint, evergreen, light flowers, fresh fruit. Retsina stems from the ancient practice of using pine resin to line amphora, acting as a preservative and sanitizer.*

### RED: LIVELY & BRIGHT

- B211 **Cardedu “Praja”** 50  
MONICA di Sardegna, IT, 2022  
*Zingy & brambly, redcurrant, raspberry, fresh herbs, & light spice. From fourth generation, all-natural winemakers, this crunchy wine is made in cement tanks underneath their house.*
- B212 **Weingut Niklas “Fuxs”** 52  
SCHIAVA, Südtiroler Kalterer, Alto-Adige, IT, 2024  
*Light-bodied & bright, forest berries, orange peel, alpine herbs. Schiava is an ancient grape, similar to Pinot Noir. Named after the word “slave” for its need for Pergola training.*
- B213 **Rubinelli Vajol** 56  
CORVINA-CORVINONE-RONDINELLA-MOLINARA, Valpolicella Classico, Veneto, IT, 2021  
*Honest & expressive, pomegranate, ripe cherry, redcurrant, juniper & roses. As a testament to tradition and honest winemaking, the Rubinelli family is committed to sustainability.*
- B214 **Lamoresca “Nerocapitano”** 66  
FRAPPATO, Sicilia, IT, 2023  
*All natural & fresh, ripe strawberries, raspberries, wildflowers, ocean breezes. In the Sicilian dialect Frappato is referred to as “Capitano Nero,” the namesake for this bottling.*

**RED: FRUIT BOMBS AWAY**

- B215 **Lunaria “Coste di Moro”** 40  
MONTEPULCIANO d’Abruzzo, IT, 2019  
*Fruit bomb & decadent, black cherry jam, cocoa, toast. With over 450 partners, this is the largest organic & biodynamic cooperative in southern Italy farming over 1,100 hectares.*
- B221 **Conestabile della Staffa “Il Rosso Due Colli”** 56  
GAMAY DEL TRASIMENO (Grenache), Umbria, IT, 2023  
*Vibrant & full, ripe strawberry, maraschino cherries, pine trees, white pepper. Legend says Duchess Eleonora Mendoza brought Spanish Grenache vines as her dowry to Italy in 1610.*
- B222 **Conti di Buscareto** 55  
LACRIMA DI MORRO d’Alba, Marche, IT, 2023  
*Full-bodied & velvety, red woodland berries, rose petals, pink pepper. A grape that was on the verge of extinction, its resurgence happened after the region acquired DOC status in 1985.*
- B223 **Zanotelli** 66  
PINOT NERO, Trentino-Alto Adige, IT, 2021  
*Fruit driven & juicy pinot noir, strawberry, cherry, clove, coffee. Pinot Nero is the Italian name for the French grape, where “pinot” refers to the tight pine cone-like clusters of this variety.*
- B224 **Fratelli Ponte** 54  
BARBERA d’Asti Superiore, Piemonte, IT, 2020  
*Round & fruity, tart cherry, strawberries, baking spices, herbs. In collaboration w/ the artist Romano Levi, the label depicts a house w/ a fireplace, symbolizing “conviviality of family.”*
- B225 **Summer Wolff “Gio Gio”** 64  
FREISA-NEBBIOLO-BARBERA, Montaldo di Cellina, Piemonte, IT, 2023  
*Structured & plush, ripe blackberry, red plum, rosehips, grilled herbs. A relative to Nebbiolo, Freisa originated in Piemonte, where it adds tannic structure & florality to wines.*
- B226 **Kontozisis Vineyards “Innocent Dove”** 50  
XINOMAVRO-MERLOT, Karditsa, GR, 2019  
*Dynamic & aromatic, strawberry, fruit cake, white pepper, tomato leaf. Whole-cluster fermented, this wine softens the tannic notes of Xinomavro w/ the plushier Merlot.*
- B227 **Domaine Thymiopoulos “Terra Petra”** 70  
XINOMAVRO-KRASSATO-STAVROTO, Rapsani, Thessalia, GR, 2020  
*Refined & elegant, soft red fruit, sun-dried tomato, tea leaves, lavender, vanilla. Rapsani, located on the foothills of Mt. Olympus, was one of Greece’s first delineated wine regions.*

**RED: FULLY DARING**

- B231 **Nasiakos** **54**  
AGIORGITIKO, Nemea, GR, 2021  
*Concentrated & plush, cherry, plum, violet, pepper, cedar. Agiorgitiko is nicknamed “the blood of Hercules” as it is legend he consumed the wine before defeating the Nemean Lion.*
- B232 **Ktima Spiropoulos “Porfyros”** **60**  
AGIORGITIKO-MERLOT-CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Peloponnese, GR, 2018  
*Rich & structured, cola, soft red berries, black pepper, vanilla, cinnamon. A Greek Bordeaux: this wine marries the indigenous “St. George Grape” w/ French varieties in French oak.*
- B233 **Cosimo Taurino “Notarpanaro”** **68**  
NEGROAMARO, Guagnano, Puglia, IT, 2012  
*Heavy & enduring, orange peel, brandied cherries, spiced game, herbs. Negroamaro is a dark grape known for its rustic and earth-driven wines produced almost exclusively from Puglia.*
- B234 **Cantina Peppucci “L’alto Io” Rosso** **76**  
SAGRANTINO-CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Umbria, IT, 2015  
*Bold & inky, ripe forest berries, black plums, tobacco, & vanilla. Sagrantino, the famous variety of Umbria, has the highest level of polyphenols (antioxidants) of any grape variety.*
- B235 **Massimago “Marchesa MariaBella”** **85**  
CORVINA-CORVINONE-RONDINELLA, Valpolicella Ripasso, Veneto, IT, 2022  
*Structured & fruit-driven, tart black cherries, wild strawberries, fresh herbs. A unique process, where wine is repassed over pressed Amarone grapes to extract residual flavour & color.*
- B236 **Ca la Bionda “Ravazzol”** **130**  
CORVINA-CORVINONE-RONDINELLA, Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Veneto, IT, 2019  
*Complex & raisiny, black cherries, blackberries, ground ginger, licorice. Amarone stems from the expensive process of Appassimento - drying the grapes on mats to concentrate the juice.*
- B237 **Di Majo Norante “Sassius” Riserva** **120**  
AGLIANICO di Molise, IT, 2016  
*Powerful & rich, wild cherry, blackcurrant, violet, licorice, cacao, sweet spice. Aglianico is known for producing deeply structured & tannic wines that can develop complexity w/ age.*
- B238 **Cantina Gungui “Berteru” Riserva** **135**  
CANNONAU di Sardegna, IT, 2022  
*Lavish & vibrant, wild strawberry, black berry, dried mint, smokey sage. From Alberello, Or bush trained Garnacha grapes planted in the 1950s. Only 1350 bottles were produced.*

## RED: GREAT ETNA-TATIONS

- B241 **Tenuta Nicosia “Contrada Monte Gorna”** 65  
NERELLO MASCALESE-NERELLO CAPPUCCIO, Etna Rosso, Sicilia, IT, 2021  
*Structured & lively, fresh cherry, balsamic strawberry, lavender, smoke. From a specific site, or “contrada,” Nicosia is one of the founding fathers of Etna, helping to write the DOC laws.*
- B242 **Eduardo Torres Acosta “Pirrera”** 100  
NERELLO MASCALESE, Terre Siciliane, IT, 2022  
*Refined w/ inner tension, dried lavender flowers, crushed herbs, smoky strawberry. Pirrera is a single site on Mt. Etna, where its rocky-volcanic ash soils formed from the 1614 eruption.*
- B243 **Emiliano Falsini “Contrada Feudo Pignatone”** 120  
NERELLO MASCALESE, Etna Rosso, Sicilia, IT, 2023  
*Complex & nuanced, wild strawberry, fennel, rose, incense, mixed herbs. From a special plot on the northern side of Etna, Falsini promotes terroir, using 30-100 year old vines in this Rosso.*
- B244 **Tenuta delle Terre Nere “San Lorenzo”** 140  
NERELLO MASCALESE, Etna Rosso, Sicilia, IT, 2023  
*Powerful w/ silken textures, blood orange, red cherries, cinnamon, & clove. A revered bottle from one of only two sites on pure Ellittico soils, the oldest superficial strata on Mt. Etna.*
- BR06 **Vini Franchetti “Terre Siciliane”** 260  
PETIT VERDOT-CESANESE d’AFFILE, Castiglione di Sicilia, IT, 2020  
*Profound & rich, dark berries, sage, spices, lavender, smoke. This “Super-Etnean” is the vision of the winemaker, who daringly crafted a deep wine as black as the lava that flows from Etna.*

### HOW TO PAIR WINE W/ FOOD:

The secret: there is no right or wrong way to pair food and wine. If you enjoy the combination, then it is the perfect pairing for you. There are some guidelines, however, which might help when choosing:

#### What grows together, goes together.

If your dish is from Tuscany, then a Tuscan wine should complement your meal.  
Typically, the regional & cultural styles of food & wine develop together to be enjoyed together.

#### The weight of the food should match the wine.

A richer dish has the potential to stand up to a richer & more complex wine.  
Vice versa, a lighter dish usually works best with a lighter styled wine.

**RED: SANGIOVESE CENTRAL**

- B251 **Sono Montenidoli “Il Garrulo”** **65**  
SANGIOVESE-CANAIOLA-TREBBIANO-MALVASIA, Chianti Colli Senesi, Toscana, IT, 2021  
*Classic expression, lively & bright, cherry, blackberry, wild rosemary, thyme. Montenidoli, or the mountain of little nests, has been a site for vine growing since the Etruscans.*
- B252 **Tenuta di Gracciano della Seta** **68**  
SANGIOVESE-MERLOT, Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Toscana, IT, 2022  
*Full-bodied & rustic, black cherry, cooked plum, anise, red roses, spice. In Montepulciano, “Bravio delle Botti” is an annual, competitive race of rolling wine barrels through the city.*
- B253 **Luteraia “Toscana Rosso”** **82**

SANGIOVESE, Chianti Classico, Toscana, IT, 2016  
*Deep & earthy, ripe dark cherry, brambly blackberry, cocoa nibs, sandalwood. The vines were planted in the 1970’s at the family estate, the northernmost zone in the Chianti Classico DOCG.*
- B256 **Castello di Monsanto “Il Poggio” Gran Selezione** **170**  
SANGIOVESE-COLORINO, Chianti Classico, Toscana, IT, 2018  
*Emboldened w/ firm structure, blackcurrant, blackberry, sour cherry, black olives, roasted game, licorice. Gran Selezione is a stricter designation for an estate Chianti Classico Riserva.*
- B257 **Tenuta Caparzo** **100**  
SANGIOVESE, Brunello di Montalcino, Toscana, IT, 2019  
*Layered w/ reserved power, raspberry, cassis, lilac, earth, garden herbs. To be labeled “Brunello,” the wine must be 100% Sangiovese, & aged for a minimum of 5 years, w/ 2 in oak.*

SANGIOVESE, Brunello di Montalcino, Toscana, IT, 2016  
*Concentrated & meticulously crafted, dark cherry, deep plum, dried rosemary, vanilla, leather. A classic expression from a small 2-ha plot of low-yielding vines; only 500 bottles were produced.*

*Suave & lush, blackcurrant, cherry, leather, dark chocolate, violets. Originally founded in 1370, the Tenuta di Ghizzano estate has been producing wines from Italy for over 26 generations.*

*Structured & persistent, black cherry, red raspberry, blueberry, violets, jalapeno, spice. This wine is blended after aging 58% in cocciopesto amphora (made from crushed stone & brick).*

MERLOT-CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Bolgheri, Toscana, IT, 2022

*Harmonious & full-bodied, rich plum, mushrooms, Bing cherries. An excellent introduction to Barbaresco (“the queen of Italian wine”), this house produces quality, fruit-driven wines.*

NEBBIOLO, Barbaresco Serraboella, Piemonte, IT, 2020  
*Sun-kissed & polished, ripe red cherry, currants, mushrooms, dried herbs. Stemming from Barbaresco’s most famous cru, Serraboella, the warmer site adds power & volume to the wine.*
- B264 **Guidobono** 95  
NEBBIOLO, Barolo Le Coste di Monforte, Piemonte, IT, 2020  
*Elegant & aromatic, rose, raspberry, licorice, spice. From a special plot within Barolo, this Nebbiolo showcases traditional practices & is the winemaker’s premium bottling.*
- B265 **Giacomo Borgogno e Figli** 130
